Scheme for merger of Public Trust.

[1] Name of the Institution :

The name of this trust shall be Dr. Subhash Pethaljibhai Chavda Ahir Kelavani Mandal, Junagadh – Registration No. : E – 399, Junagadh.

[2] Objectives of the Trust :

The objectives of the institution shall be as under :

- [1] To undertake all the attempts for the spread of education in society.
- [2] To establish, to run and to maintain institutions, like Pre-Primary-Schools, Montessory Schools, Ashram Schools, Night Schools, Adult education Schools, Primary Schools, Secondary Schools, Higher education Colleges, Physical education Centres and also academies for imparting education to society as per the demand of the hour.
- [3] To establish, to run and maintain libraries etc. for students and also to organise ' Book – Fair '.
- [4] To publish and to keep 'Educational Text Books' and also to instal the necessary Publication machinery.
- [5] To provide every type of assistance to the needy students and enable them to further their pursuit of education.
- [6] To set up Scholarship and Fellowships for different courses and to confer such Scholarships and Fellowships upon deserving Scholars.
- [7] To raise funds for 'Economically Weaker' students and set up "Poor Boys' Fund".
- [8] To establish Technological Academies in order to encourage youth to inculcate interest in the technological field and to organise 'Cultural Fairs', 'Seminars' , pertaining to technology and to sponsor scholars, in the respective field, to foreign countries for furtherance of the knowledge.
- [9] To be helpful to the brilliant and promising students by rendering them all sort of help in the pursuit of knowledge.

- [10] To establish, to run and to maintain hostels, boardings and ashrams for the students.
- [11] The Institution, when deems fit and necessary is authorised to start an Autonomous Educational Complex.
- [12] The Institution will be authorised to establish, run and maintain an Autonomous Institution on the pattern of University or Vidhyapith..

[3] **Number of Trustees and their eligibility :**

- [1] The minimum strength of the members of the trust shall be five (5) and the maximum seven (7) and these members shall be Life – Members.
- [2] These trustees shall appoint, by majority vote, new trustees from among highly qualified and eminent personalities and who believe in the interests and welfare of the Institution.
- [3] Prime Trustees :
- [i] Shri Pethaljibhai Nathabhai Chavda
- [ii] Smt. Sonaben Pethaljibhai Chavda
- [iii] Shri Javahar Pethaljibhai Chavda
- [iv] Shri Nishith Pethaljibhai Chavda
- [v] Shri Nathabhai Laxmanbhai Chavda

[4] **To fill the vacant seat of the trustee :**

- [a] The post shall be deemed to have fallen vacant from among the trustee, appointed by virtue of the said scheme, or from among any other trustees appointed henceforth on the post that has fallen vacant, because of the trustee's resignation, demise, insolvency, unwillingness to continue to be a trustee, being convicted for some criminal offence, becoming unable or showing inability to execute his powers or perform his duty or showing his unwillingness to do so. The remaining trustees, by majority, shall appoint some deserving person, as a trustee, within three months, on the vacant post. And if such post is not filled within three months, after three months, the Joint Charity Commissioner, vide article – 3 shall be empowered to appoint a new trustee.

- [5] (a) If some trustee is found guilty of being involved in doing some activities against the interests of the trust and if other members of the trust, by majority, succeed in proving that he has been involved so, in such circumstances the accused shall be given a chance to prove himself innocent and even then if the trustees find him guilty, such a post shall be

declared to have fallen vacant and to make a fresh appointment of the trustee, the Joint Charity Commissioner shall be applied to.

- (b) The newly appointed trustee(s) shall be required to submit a written consent to the trust before his (their) appointment as a trustee(s) to work and remain as a trustee(s). And after receipt of such consent, such a trustee(s) shall be considered as the Prime Trustee(s) of the trust.

[6] **Office – Bearers :**

- [1] The trustees shall elect office-Bearers from amongst the trustees :
- (i) The President
 - (ii) The Vice – President
 - (iii) The General Secretary
 - (iv) The Joint – Secretary
 - (v) The Treasurer
- [2] If the President, in the meeting of the trustees, is for any reasons absent, the remaining trustees, present in the meeting shall appoint the President any one from among themselves, exclusively for the meeting and the proceedings of the meeting shall be considered legal.

[7] **Meeting of the Trust :**

In a year, at-least two meetings of the members of the trust, in any circumstances shall have to be called and such a meeting shall be called 'The Statutory Meeting' . Over and above this, the trustees are empowered to call an extra meeting and such a meeting shall be convened ' The Extra Ordinary Meeting'. The Venue of ' The Annual General Meeting ' shall be the Registered Office of the Trust but, for any reasons if is not possible, it shall be held at the Venue fixed by the President.

- [8] If two third (2/3) trustees of the trust want an ' Extra Ordinary Meeting ', for some special reason(s) and submit a 'Requisition' to the President, the President shall be required to convene such a meeting for the 'Requisition Work', within a week from the date of the 'Requisition Letter'. And if the President fails to convene such a meeting within a week from the date of 'Requisition Letter', the trustees, who have made the 'Requisition' shall be empowered to convene a meeting at the Registered Office of the Trust.

[9] **Notice of the Meeting :**

Each trustee shall be required to be notified by post or by a circular, about the meeting at least three days before the schedule date of the meeting and due

signature to this effect need be taken from each member. Regarding sending of the notice, if some changes in the rules, are framed by the trustees, in such circumstances, the notice under the changed rules shall have to be sent.

[10] **Corrum :**

If the committee consists of seven (7) members, the Corrum for the meeting of the trustees shall be five (5). If the Corrum is not formed within half an hour after the time of the meeting, the meeting shall be postponed and such meeting shall be convened after an hour, on the same day and the Corrum shall not be a bar to such a meeting and the proceedings of such a meeting shall be considered legal.

[11] **Resolutions regarding Circulars :**

If all the trustees of the trust are not in a position to meet at a time for day to day or routine work of the trust, the trustees through circular-resolutions can without convening a meeting, take decisions concerning some important work that need be urgently disposed and proceedings of such meetings shall be treated legal.

[12] **Minutes - Book :**

- (a) A Minutes-Book shall be maintained in the office of the trust to record day-to-day proceedings and resolutions. All the business transacted in the 'General Meeting' and the details of the resolutions passed through circulars shall be recorded in the Minutes-Book.
- (b) The Minutes-Book shall be signed by the President of the trust in the following meeting after having duly been passed. And in case any controversy arises, at the instance of the majority of the trustees attendings the last meeting, the necessary remarks regarding the controversy shall be recorded.

[13] **The Assets of the trust :**

The fixed and working assets as are mentioned in the P.T.R. of both the trusts and any addition in them and the assets that are acquired thence after by the trust shall be the properties of the trust and shall be kept on the name of the trust.

[14] The assets of the trust shall Vest on the name of the trustees and the management and administration of such properties shall be subject to the norms of the trust.

[15] **Vesting of the trust Assets on the name of the new trustee(s).**

As and when new trustee(s) shall be appointed, the assets, that vest on the names of the existing trustees, shall simultaneously be vested on the name of the new trustee(s).



[16] The members of the trust, at the respective time, by resolution shall keep the Fixed Assets of the trust on the name of any two trustees of which one shall be the President of the trust.

[17] Maintaining of the Accounts of the Trust :

The Trustees shall be required to properly maintain the assets, incomes and expenses of the trust and the accounts of the trust shall have got to be audited immediately after the conclusion of the Financial Year.

[18] The Financial Year of the Trust :

31 st March shall be maintained as the financial year of the Trust.

[19] Regarding Cash-doles and Gifts of any nature received by the Trust :

Rents from the trust properties, incomes earned from sources, dividends, interest income, cash-doles and gifts and other miscellaneous income received by the trust shall be treated as the income of the trust.

[20] Regarding expenses of the Trust :

The trustees shall meet expenses of the administration and management of the trust from the income earned through rents, interests, profits and produces from the land of the trust. The trustees shall transfer minimum of 5 % and or more they deem fit towards the Reserve Funds of the trust and the trustees shall be required to meet expenses, when necessary, from the Reserve Funds and to accomplish the objectives of trust, the remaining expenses shall be met from the remaining income.

[21] The Cash money and assets of the trust shall require to be maintained vide The Bombay Public Trust Act 1950, Article-35. The money not required, must be deposited in a bank. All the accounts in the bank(s) shall have to be maintained on the name of the trust. But if the trust feels it not suitable, it may be deposited on the names of at least two trustees and jointly operated by them.

[22] Transfer of Fixed Assets of the Trust :

Regarding transfer of the Fixed Assets of the trust, the members of the trust, after having passed resolution and having sought permission from the Charity/ Joint Charity Commissioner vide The Bombay Public Trust Act 1950, Article-36, shall be able to seek loan against the Fixed Assets, sell or gift or exchange the Fixed Assets of the trust.

[23] Register :

The trustees shall be required to prepare a detailed list of valuables furniture and working assets of the trust. The trustees or the trustees so authorised shall be



required to sign on each detail and on the details included in the list. The items mentioned in the Register shall require to be tallied at least once in a year and the trustees shall sign to this effect.

[24] Regarding appointment of the employees :

For the administration of the trust, the trustees can appoint as many employees on the terms and conditions, wages and salary, as they deem fit and services of such employees can be terminated as the trustees deem fit.

[25] Regarding appointment of Sub-Committees :

For the administration of any nature of the trust, the trustees can appoint a sub-committee from amongst themselves, if they deem fit. The Sub-Committee shall submit its report to the trustees and after the due deliberations on the report, the trustees might accept it in toto and or in part and their decision shall be final.

[26] Framing of Rules :

The trust, for the smooth running of the scheme, proper maintenance and fulfilment of the objectives of the trust, can frame rules, as per its discretion and a written permission of the Charity/Joint Charity Commissioner has to be sought on the said rules and, after seeking permission from the Charity/Joint Charity Commissioner, the trust can, if it deems fit, introduce changes in the rules. The rules framed for the scheme and rectifications made in the articles of the plan, must be in tune with the rules framed under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950.

[27] Regarding Changes in the Plan :

After giving the necessary notice to the trustees, more than two trustees, or the trustees including the Charity/Joint Charity Commissioner, having the interest of the trust at heart, can introduce, changes and rectifications, if they deem fit, in the scheme.

[28] Regarding Changes :

Any changes in the trustees, Fixed Assets or Working Assets of the trust must be notified (made known), within three months of its changes, to be Registered Office of the trust.

[29] Regarding the interpretation of the clauses of the trust deed :

The trustees shall be required to make a written application to the Charity/Joint Charity Commissioner regarding any controversy(ies) about the interpretation of the clauses of the scheme, the verdict of the Charity/Joint Charity Commissioner shall be final and binding on all.



GUJARAT ACT NO. 7 OF 2022.

(First published, after having received the assent of the Governor, in the "Gujarat Government Gazette", on the 7th April, 2022).

AN ACT

further to amend the Gujarat Private Universities Act, 2009.

WHEREAS the Platinum Foundation, Rohera Orchade, Ahmedabad; Dr. Subhash P. Chavda Ahir Kelvani Mandal, Junagadh; Transstidia Education & Research Foundation, Ahmedabad; Shree Vithalprabhu Education and Charitable Trust, Patan; Vidhyadeep Charitable Trust, Surat; Janak Madan Charitable Education Trust, Ahmedabad; Mahagujarat Medical Society, Kheda; Shree Swaminarayan Vishvamangal Gurukul, Gandhinagar; Adani Institute for Education and Research (AIER), Ahmedabad; Lokbharati Gram Vidhyapith, Bhavnagar and Shri Vivek Bharti Trust, Junagadh have applied to the State Government under the provisions of the Gujarat Private Universities Act, 2009 to establish Private Universities in the State;



AND WHEREAS the said applications have been scrutinised by the Scrutiny Committee and on the report of the Scrutiny Committee, the State Government has issued the Letter of Intent to the respective sponsoring body for establishment of the Private University;

AND WHEREAS the State Government is satisfied that the sponsoring bodies have complied with the conditions of Letter of Intent as provided in section 10 of the said Act and have also established the Endowment fund as per the Letter of Intent;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Government of Gujarat, in accordance with the provisions of section 10 of the Act, includes the institutions specified in column 2 of the Schedule as the Private University, by the name and location of the aforesaid sponsoring bodies as specified in column 4 of the Schedule.

It is hereby enacted in the Seventy-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Gujarat Private Universities (Amendment) Act, 2022.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the *Official Gazette*, appoint.

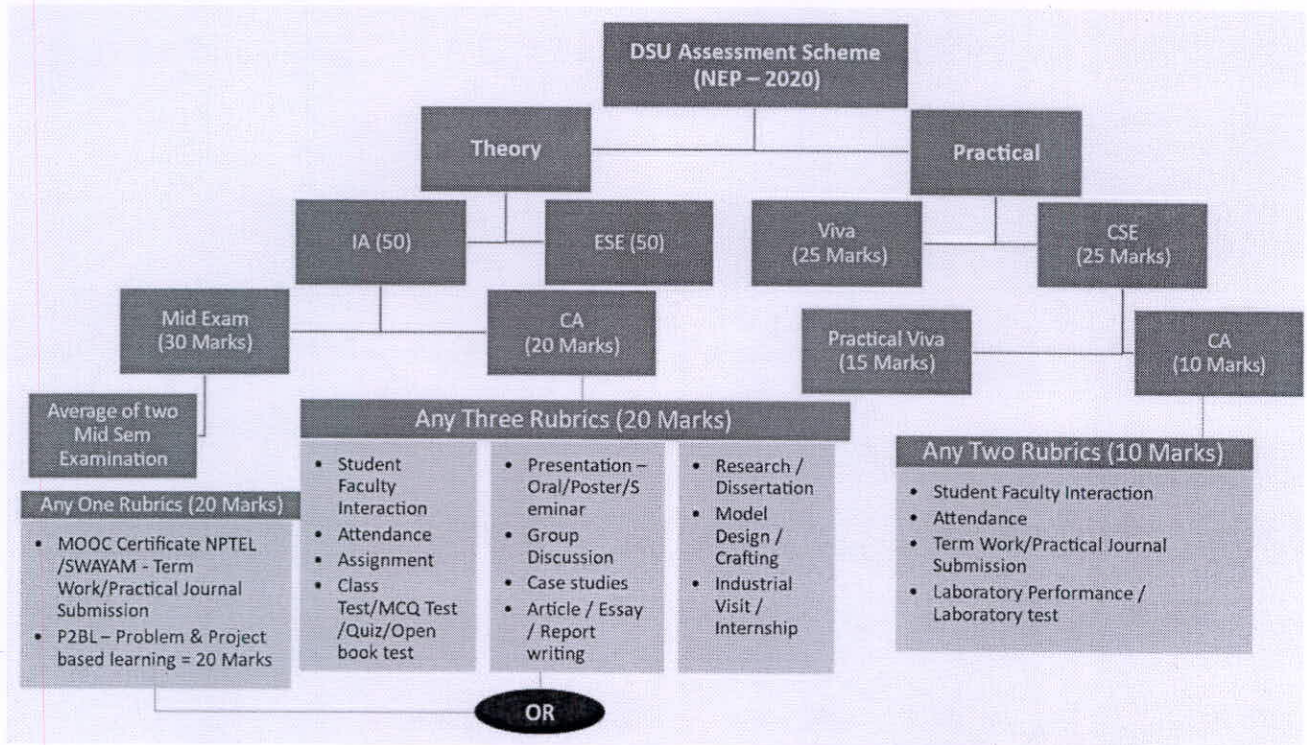

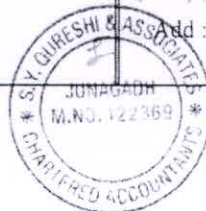

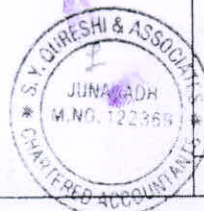

Annexure – O

1.1 The Governing Body

The Governing Body shall be the sovereign authority of the University & shall exercise powers as specified in Section 20 (5) of the Act. The Constitution of the Governing Body, the meeting pattern shall be in accordance with Section 20(1) of the Act.

1.1.1 Constitution of the Governing Body

Governing Body of the University shall consist of the following members, namely -

- i. The President (Ex-officio);
- ii. The Provost (Ex-officio);
- iii. Four Persons to be nominated by the Sponsoring Body out of which two shall be eminent educationists;
- iv. Two Deans or officers of the Constituent Institutes or Centres or the University, by rotation, to be nominated by the Provost;
- v. One expert of Management or Information technology from outside the University to be nominated by the Governing Body;
- vi. Three experts representing other disciplines such as Finance, Legal and Social Sector to be nominated by the Governing Body;
- vii. One eminent industrialist to be nominated by the Governing Body;
- viii. Secretary to the Government of Gujarat, Higher and Technical Education or his/her representative not below the rank of Deputy Secretary to Government or the Deputy Commissioner (Ex-officio); and
- ix. Registrar as a member secretary (Ex-officio)

1.2 The Board of Management

The Board of Management shall be the Executive Council of the University. The Constitution of the Board of Management and the meeting pattern shall be in accordance with Section 21(1) of the Act.

1.2.1 Constitution of the Board of Management

The Board of Management shall consist of the following persons, namely:

- i. The President (Ex-officio);
- ii. The Provost (Ex-officio);
- iii. Two members of the Governing Body to be nominated by the Sponsoring Body;



- iv. Two persons who are not members of Governing Body to be nominated by the Sponsoring Body;
- v. Three persons from amongst the faculty members of the University to be nominated by the Sponsoring Body;
- vi. One faculty member, to be nominated by the President; and
- vii. Registrar as a Member Secretary (Ex-officio)

1.3 The Academic Council

The Academic shall be the Principal Academic Body of the University.

1.3.1 Constitution of the Academic Council

The constitution of Academic council shall be in accordance Section 22 of the Act and statutes shall consist of the following members.

- i. The Provost (Ex-officio);
- ii. Deans of the University (Ex-officio);
- iii. Not more than two officers, to be nominated by the Board of Management on the recommendations of the Provost;
- iv. Library and Information Centre in-charge (Ex-officio);
- v. The Controller of Examination (Ex-officio);
- vi. Two persons from among the Teaching Staff having excellent API score to be nominated by the Provost;
- vii. Two eminent educationists from outside the University to be nominated by the President;
- viii. Two persons from Industry to be nominated by the Board of Management;
- ix. The Registrar as the member secretary (Ex-officio)

1.4 The Research and Innovation Council

The Research and Innovation Council shall be the Principal Research and Innovation Committee of the University which shall provide the larger holistic vision of the kind of research to be undertaken by the University, including prioritization of the research areas.

1.4.1 Constitution of the Research and Innovation Council

The Constitution of the Research and Innovation Council shall be in accordance with Section 19 (d) of the Act 2009.

- i. Provost (Ex-officio);
- ii. Registrar as Member Secretary (Ex-officio);
- iii. Controller of Examination (Ex-officio);



- iv. There shall be maximum three external experts in the field of Higher and Professional education, to be nominated by the Provost, with the endorsement of the President;
- v. Dean of Institutes (Ex-officio);
- vi. Two members to be nominated by the Sponsoring body;

1.5 The Finance Committee

1.5.1 Constitution of the Finance Committee

The Finance Committee of the University shall consist of following members:

- i. The President;
- ii. The Provost;
- iii. The Registrar;
- iv. The Chief Finance and Accounts Officer (Member Secretary);
- v. One person to be nominated by the Board of Management having expertise in Finance;
- vi. One member to be nominated by the Governing Body having expertise of Finance;

1.6 The Board of Studies

There shall be Boards of Studies formed in accordance with Section 19 (d) of the Act.

1.6.1 Constitution of the Board of Studies

Each Faculty shall have a Board of Studies and shall be formed by the Board of Management. In specific cases, two or more Institutes can have one common Board as may be determined by the Provost.

The term of office of the constituted Board of Studies & its members shall be of two years.

- i. Dean/Head of Department of the concerned School – (Chairman);
- ii. Nominee of the Provost (Dean – in case of a Head as chairman);
- iii. Two senior faculties of each specialization;
- iv. Two external experts of the related faculty to be nominated by the Academic Council;
- v. One representative from the Industry/Corporate Sector/Allied area practitioner;
- vi. The Provost may appoint members as the Special Invitee with the consent of the Chairman up to a maximum of three members for a particular meeting depending on the proficiency required for the agenda.


