Diverse Subject Coverage : The collection spans a wide array of academic disciplines, catering to various teaching and learning requirements.

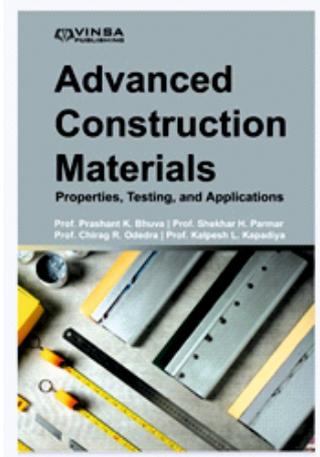
