### 1. **Craft Your Art! : Thali Decoration Competition**

- Theme: Ensure the decoration aligns with the 'Lord Ganesha'
- Originality & Innovative use of material are encouraged
- Decoration should be neat and well organised
- Students have to submit their decorated thali on 26 Aug, 2025 during 11:00 to 12:00 PM at Multipurpose Hall

### 2. **#VinayakaatDSU: Reel Making Competition**

- Theme: Capturing Vinayaka's Vibes at DSU
- Shoot your reels inside the DSU campus
- Shoot your reels either be in portrait or landscape mode
- Form a team of passionate film makers maximum of 4 members from any school
- Duration: 60-90 seconds
- Use #vinayakaatDSU & mention official social media handle of our university.
- Students should focus on content creativity, originality, cinematography, editing, sound selection and campus representation.
- Students have to upload their reel by 02 Sept, 2025 before 10:00AM.

### 3. **Paint Your Ganesha! : Painting Competition**

- Theme: Forms of Ganesha
- Participants can draw and paint their favourite form of Lord Ganesha.
- Drawing Sheet will be provided to each participant.
- Students have to bring their own stationery materials.
- Drawing should be neat and clean demonstrated with fair strokes of colors.
- Participants needs to focus on Creativity, Originality and Quality of the art along with the event's theme
- Competition will be organised on 28 Aug, 2025 during 11:00 AM to 01:30 PM at Multipurpose Hall

### 4. **Making Moraya! : Ganesha Making Competition**

- Theme: Making Eco-friendly Idol of Ganesha
- Participants can make Idol of Lord Ganesha from any material of their choice which is eco-friendly (eg. Clay, Leaves etc)
- All the required material that needs to be arranged by the participants only.
- Participants need to focus on the proper shape of Idol, well crafted Idol with innovative ideas and use of qualitative material.
- Competition will be organised on 29 Aug, 2025 during 11:00 AM to 01:30 PM at Multipurpose Hall

### 5. **Laddoo Making Competition**

- Individual or team entries (max. 2 members per team).
- Participants must bring their own ingredients.
- Only vegetarian ingredients are allowed.
- Preparation & presentation time: 1 hour

- Late entries will not be considered for judgment.
- Proper hygiene must be maintained during preparation.
- Participants should bring clean utensils & maintain a neat workstation.
- Minimum 10 laddus to be presented for judging.
- Each plate must be clearly labeled with the participant/team name.
- Competition will be organised on 01 Sept, 2025 at Multipurpose Hall

#### 6. **Laddoo Eating Competition**

- Only registered students of the college can participate.
- Participants must report 10 minutes before the event begins.
- Each participant will be given a fixed number of laddoos on a plate.
- The host/referee will announce the start and end.
- Participants must eat using only their hands (no assistance/tools allowed).
- Laddoos must be completely swallowed before moving to the next.
- Talking/laughing with food in mouth will lead to penalty/disqualification.
- The winner will be the participant who eats the maximum number of laddoos in the given time limit.
- If any participant feels uneasy, they should stop immediately.
- No wastage: laddoos dropped or half-eaten will not be counted.
- Judges' decisions will be final and binding.
- Duration: 5 minutes.
- Competition will be organised on 02 Sept, 2025 at Multipurpose Hall
