Subject: Summer Research Internship Program at Kyoto University, Japan (May–July 2026)

This is to inform all eligible students that Kyoto University, Japan, through its Division of Graduate Studies, has announced the KU-STAR (Kyoto University Short-Term Academic Research) Program for India. This is a prestigious Summer Research Internship Program offering selected students the opportunity to undertake advanced research at one of the world's leading universities.

Program Highlights:

- Students will participate in advanced research projects at Kyoto University, Japan under the supervision of designated faculty members.
- Research placement will be based on student interests and laboratory availability.
- The program aims to encourage students to pursue doctoral studies and research careers.

Program Duration: May 19 to July 10, 2026.

Application Period: From January 13, 2026 to January 27, 2026.

Eligible Participants:

- Undergraduate or Master's level students
- Undergraduate students must have completed at least four semesters prior to the internship.
- Not be scheduled to graduate before the start of the program.
- Continue their academic program in India for at least one semester/quarter after returning from Japan.
- Have a good academic record.

Important Note:

- Selection and final acceptance are subject to Kyoto University norms and laboratory availability.
- Students are advised to carefully read the Application Guide and Laboratory List before applying.
